Applicants must be comfortable with High Adventure activities like climbing and ziplining and confident in their ability to keep campers safe while participating.

Anticipated Hours: Arrival at 8:00 AM and Departure between 4:30-5:00 Monday-Friday. Break for lunch included. Staff Week /Camp Set Up hours may vary. Camper /Program day is 8:00 am – 4:30 pm.

Position Requirements:

- At least 21 years of age and a US Citizen
- Be a registered staff member of the Boy Scouts of America, and Youth Protection Trained
- Ability to work 8:00 AM 5:00 PM Monday through Friday.
- Maintain a current and valid driver's license in your state of residence.
- Job Category: Temporary -Full Time Seasonal (Summer Contract)
- Passion for Youth Education and Leadership

Principle Responsibilities:

- Mandatory Inventory and Hardware checks to be completed before and after the program day.
- Keeps assigned areas clean and all program supplies secured or stored away for next day.
- All Staff coordinate supervision of campers as needed in Morning Announcements, Afternoon Departures, and as needed for all other daily program (in coordination/rotation with other Program Area Coordinators)
- Arrive on time and set up your program area before camp begins.
- Position dependent on ability to satisfactorily pass required COPE training. All curriculum materials are provided, and training for programs is included during Staff Training Week.
- Other Duties as assigned to provide a safe and FUN experience for all campers and staff.
