

Summer Day Camp Lunch/ Camper Aid

Job Description

Work Location: Adventure Point 3213 Walker Avenue NW Grand Rapids, MI 49544

The Summer Day Camp Aid will work with the daily lunch program and snack program provided for each camper and all staff on camp each day. This involves setting up the lunch line in the dining pavilion each day and helping organize daily meal plans, snack plans and lunch milk delivery. This Aid will also work directly with the Program Area Directors during rotations providing mentorship and additional supervision and FUN for our campers each day.

Contract Dates: Monday – Friday, June 10 – August 9, 2024 (We are closed 7/1 – 7/5/24).

Weekly Rate: \$ 265 Work Hours: 10:00 am – 4:00 pm Lunch & breaks each day

Training Provided: Staff Training Week: June 10 – 15, 2024. Required.

On-site training at Adventure Point, will include First Aid/CPR/AED Certification, and as applicable, Climbing, Zipline, Shooting Sports and other Outdoor Programs; subject to age based BSA/NCAP approved training.

Daily Work Hours: 10:00 am – 4:00 pm. Required 30 minutes for lunch and 15-minute breaks in both AM and PM Rotation blocks. Work permit may be required from your school, please ask your counselor to help you and we will fill it out upon hire.

Position Requirements:

- Be at least <u>15 years</u> of age.
- Have transportation to and from work.
- Experience or passion for working with youth preferable, but not required.
- Will be a registered member of the BSA and take Youth Protection Training
- Will be able to work with other staff members with a collaborative attitude.
- Will be a positive role model for campers
- Will be flexible with changing daily assignments and pop-up tasks.
- Possess a parent or guardian approval and permission.

Job Category: Temporary - Seasonal (Contract)

Position Responsibilities:

- Work in youth development and become a youth role model.
- Will be responsible for knowing the program schedule. Carries a time keeping device other than a cell phone.
- Assist with and learn about nutrition based meals and easy meal set up
- Follow the rules and regulations of the Camp.
- Implement fun, challenging, age appropriate and rewarding activities for the campers including songs, skits, and small group games.
- Assist campers during lunch and snacks.
- Assist camp staff team in facility cleanliness.
